As the workshop progresses, participants will dive into Analysis Integration, learning how to embed analysis into test definitions for efficient data processing. This is complemented by a session on the Report Designer, guiding attendees through the process of creating tailored reports using recommended procedures for effective interpretation.

The final sections address advanced features, including project export/import, configuration management, User Administration, database handling, and valuable tips under "Good to Know." These topics ensure participants are prepared to manage diverse scenarios and maximize the software's potential.

By the conclusion of the workshop, attendees will have developed practical expertise and a deep understanding of the software, empowering them to streamline workflows and achieve optimal results in their analyses.
